

A Family Affair: Florian and Emily Tronel's Journey as Volunteer Tax Preparers

During the 2024 tax season, Florian and Emily Tronel, a father-daughter duo, joined the Accounting Aid Society, helping others as volunteer tax preparers. Their journey began with an online discovery by Emily's mother, who recognized her daughter's interest in numbers and accounting. At just 17 years old, Emily was eager to gain practical experience in a field she was passionate about, and the Accounting Aid Society offered the perfect blend of learning and community service. However, being a minor, Emily couldn't volunteer alone. That's when Florian stepped in, joining her as a guardian and a willing participant in a transformative experience. "My dad came along because I needed an adult to supervise," Emily shared. "But he ended up learning just as much as I did, and it was nice to have him there as a guide and support."

Florian, an engineer by profession, initially joined to support his daughter but found the experience enriching. With prior knowledge of a more straightforward tax system in their native country, France, Florian was intrigued by the complexities of the U.S. tax system. The pair attended training together, leaning on each other as they mastered new skills.

"For the first few sessions, we helped each other build confidence," Florian said. "But soon, Emily was handling her clients independently. Watching her work was incredible—she had one of the highest rates of perfect returns during quality assessments. I couldn't have been prouder."

For Emily, the experience went beyond numbers. "I learned how to interact with clients without judgment, to see the human stories behind their documents," she explained. "It was amazing to connect with people and help them through something that could be stressful." The summer program introduced Emily to other students her age who shared her interest in math and problem-solving. Working with peers from different schools, she gained a sense of camaraderie while deepening her understanding of accounting. "It was exciting to meet others like me who wanted to learn and give back to the community," she said.

Reflecting on their experience, both agreed that the most rewarding part was the human connection. "Behind every tax return is a story," Florian said. Now a confident, aspiring accountant, Emily encourages other students to join the program. "It's a great opportunity to learn, help your community, and meet incredible people," she said. Together, Florian and Emily's story is a testament to the power of volunteering to make a difference in others' lives and grow, learn, and connect as a family.


